UNIVERSITY OF MACAU OFFERS CONDOLENCES FOR PROF MIRRLEES

Professor James Mirrlees, Honorary Professor from the University of Macau (UM) and a Nobel Laureate in economics, has passed away in Cambridge, United Kingdom at the age of 82. In a statement released on Friday, UM offered its condolences on the passing of Professor Mirrlees and said that the academic will be remembered by the institution.

Professor Mirrlees was a pioneer of the economics of imperfect information, with his work laying the methodological foundations for the modern approach to decision-making under imperfect and asymmetric information.

UM conferred the title of Doctor of Social Sciences honoris causa and Honorary Professor on Professor Mirrlees in 2004 for his exceptional contributions to the field of economics.
